REGULATIONS AND SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR PERMIT TO ALLOW A DUMPSTER, CONTAINER OR SIMILAR REMOVABLE STORAGE CONTAINER, OR CONSTRUCTION VEHICLE WITHIN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY

1. **Dumpsters, containers or similar removable storage containers, or construction vehicles in the right-of-way are permitted March 16th through November 14th, only, with a maximum permit length of three continuous calendar weeks.**
2. When emergency circumstances are shown by an applicant the City may permit the placement of a dumpster, container or similar removable storage container, or any construction vehicle on or in the public right-of-way between November 15 and March 15 for a period not-to-exceed three continuous calendar weeks, weather and circumstances permitting. Emergency placement permits may be revoked due to weather conditions and snow plowing operations with forty-eight hour notice to the permittee.
3. Only rubber-tired construction vehicles will be permitted with the right-of-way.
4. All applicants shall properly guard all work within the right-of-way according to Part VI of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices current edition.
5. All dumpsters, or construction vehicles in the right-of-way at night must be visible to motorists via some type of highly visible reflective device such as reflective tape or reflectors mounted on corners of the dumpster or vehicle, lighted barricades, or other type of reflective safety equipment. Intrusive safety equipment such as flashing lights, lights powered by fueled motors, spotlights, and other similar equipment that might reasonably be determined to be disruptive to neighbors will not be allowed.
6. The pavement must be protected from any scarring. Dumping of materials on the pavement, whether it is sand, gravel, spoils material, other construction material, or debris, shall be **PROHIBITED**.
7. The project area must be kept clean of any waste material, and the surrounding area cleaned where any material has blown.
8. Any sidewalk or pavement, that may be damaged by placement of the equipment, within the right-of-way, shall be properly removed and replaced according to City of Burlington specifications.
9. Applicant is responsible for contacting owners and/or tenants, regarding disruption of foot or vehicular traffic.

With acceptance of this permit **the Applicant agrees** that the occupation of the right-of-way covered by this permit shall be performed in strict accordance with all the above regulations and the provisions of Chapter 274 of the Municipal Code. Applicant also agrees to any special conditions listed hereon, and agrees to keep and save the City free and harmless from any damages or claims against it, by whomever made, whether by reason of any failure, fault or neglect of the applicant, the applicant's agent, servants or employees in the execution of the work, or by the exercise of the privilege for which such permit is granted, or any other reason.
