Permit Acceptance and Liability Waiver (to be signed by authorized company representative or homeowner)

I request permission to excavate and/or occupy the public right-of-way in the City of Evanston in accordance with Section 7 of the City Code. For consideration of such permission, I agree to indemnify, hold harmless and defend the City of Evanston, its officers, agents and employees, from any and all claims resulting from injuries, including death, damages or losses, including, but not limited to the general public, which may arise or which may be alleged to have arisen out of, or in connection with such excavation and occupancy. I further agree to do all work in accordance with the conditions, regulations and city standards provided with this application. A copy of this permit shall be available for review at the job site at all times when work is occurring in the right-of-way.

Permit Extension Fee \$ 50.00

Driveway

Commercial \$100.00 Residential \$50.00

Street Opening \$150.00 per opening **Sidewalk/Parkway Opening** \$ 50.00 per opening

Meter Bags \$10/day/meter

Obstruction Fee

Permits for the obstruction of streets, alleys or sidewalks shall be paid in proportion to the street frontage occupied, at the rate of:

Every twenty-five feet (25') of frontage occupied, or fractional part thereof: \$25/month.

Permits for the closure of streets, alleys, or sidewalks/parkways shall be paid in accordance with the following schedule:

Sidewalk/Parkway \$ 25.00/25 linear ft. (7 days or less)
Parking Lane \$ 25.00/25 linear ft. (7 days or less)
Traffic Lane or Alley \$ 25.00/25 linear ft. (7 days or less)

Sidewalk/Parkway \$ 50.00/25 linear ft./month (more than 7 days)
Parking Lane \$ 50.00/25 linear ft./month (more than 7 days)
Traffic Lane or Alley \$ 50.00/25 linear ft./month (more than 7 days)

Dumpster / Container Fee is based on Obstruction Fee schedule for closures.

Sidewalk Sign Fee \$ 100/ year

<u>PENALTIES</u>: The penalty shall be \$500 per day if the permit expires and the obstruction remains; however, the Director of Public Works may extend the permit upon request by the applicant. The penalty shall be \$500 per day for obstructing the public way without a permit (except in cases of emergency); however, if all permit requirements are subsequently met and a permit is issued, the penalty may be reduced to an amount equal to the first month's permit fee using the schedule above.

Utility Agency

There is no fee for those utilities covered by Franchise Agreement.
